IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Validating the Franco-American Oblate Fathers, Inc.,
as a Legal Entity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Franco-American Oblate Fathers, Inc.; validated. The Franco-American Oblate Fathers, Inc., formed by chapter 47 of the private and special laws of 1949, shall continue to be legal entity from August 6, 1951 to date, notwithstanding the failure to file the certificate of organization of the said corporation within the requisite time period with the Secretary of State and the Hancock County registry of deeds; and to ratify, confirm and validate the acts of the board of trustees and officers of said Franco-American Oblate Fathers, Inc., from August 6, 1951 to date.
