AN ACT Relating to Name of Maine Ambulance and Rescue Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority to use name. The Maine Ambulance and Rescue Association, which will be incorporated, is granted the authority to use the name "Maine Ambulance and Rescue Association, Inc."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This organization has membership from all counties of the State. They have had over 400 shoulder patches made for their members, had materials printed and other preparations made. It is necessary for the Legislature to permit the use of the name under which the association will be incorporated.
