Amend said Bill by striking out in the
Title the words "and Tour"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in
the last line before the Statement of Fact the
underlined words "or tour" and inserting in
place thereof the following underlined words:
'and under regulation by the Public Utilities
Commission'

The intent of this amendment is to exempt
four buses under the Act and provide that
charter buses be under regulation by the Public
Utilities Commission.
