SENATE AMENDMENT A to H.P. 721, L.D. 897, Bill, "AN ACT to Designate the Honeybee as the Official Insect for the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in the title by changing the word "Honeybee" to 'Monarch Butterfly'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last sentence before the statement of fact, the underlined word "honeybee" and inserting in place thereof the words 'monarch butterfly'
