HOUSE AMENDMENT "N " to H.P. 1437, L.D. 1452,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Fund Public School Education."

Amend said Bill in section 30 by striking out in the 8th line of the last paragraph of that part designated subsection 11 (7th line in L.D.) the underlined word "may" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'shall'

Statement of Fact

This amendment, by changing "may" to "shall" accomplishes 2 purposes:

1. It ensures that any municipality satisfying the requirements for additional appropriations must receive authority for those appropriations from the State Board of Education; and

2. It puts any municipality denied authority for additional appropriations in a better position than under the proposed bill to appeal that denial to the Superior Court.
