HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1488, L.D.1680, 11, "AN ACT Relating to Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse or Neglect."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§3853." by striking out in the 7th line (6th line of L.D.) the underlined word "believe" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'suspect'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§3855." by striking out in the 5th line (4th line of L.D.) the underlined word "believe" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'suspect'

Statement of Fact

This amendment, by changing "believe" to "suspect" in 2 places in the bill, makes the language of the bill concerning professionals consistent with other provisions of the bill concerning child abuse or neglect.
