SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "O" to H.P. 2020,
L.D. 2196, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to Funding
of Public Schools."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of the first
underlined sentence of the 22nd paragraph and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'The uniform property tax rate shall be 13 mills for the period
beginning July 1, 1976, and ending June 30, 1977, and 12.5 mills
thereafter.'
