the last paragraph from the end, before the statement of fact,  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Shall section 16 of 'AN ACT to Improve Solid Waste  
Management,' which section requires a minimum 5¢ deposit  
on all returnable beverage containers, as passed by the First  
Special Session of the 107th Legislature, become law?"
