Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper
Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment in "PART A" under the caption "Educational
and Cultural Services" by inserting at the end the following:

'Central Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 20,550

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$20,550

Eastern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 22,900

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$22,900

Kennebec Valley Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 8,500

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$8,500

Northern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 23,200

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$23,200

Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 73,400

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$73,400

Washington County Vocational Technical Institute

All Other 12,050

Provides additional operating funds.
Increases undedicated revenue \$12,050'

Further amend said Amendment in "Part A" by adjusting in the
last line the "TOTAL GENERAL FUND -- PART A" to read correctly.

This amendment will provide additional operating funds for
the vocational technical institutes of the State and increases
undedicated revenue \$160,600 by increasing tuition.
