HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 813, L.D. 2355, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment in "Part A" under the caption "HUMAN SERVICES" by striking out everything under the heading "Aid to Families with Dependent Children" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other	(5,188,400)
All Other	1,000,000

To be used as of October 1, 1976 solely for the purpose of increasing AFDC grants for all eligible recipients.'

Further amend said Amendment in "Part A" by adjusting in the last line the "TOTAL GENERAL FUND --PART A" to read correctly.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for a minimal increase to aid to families with dependent children benefits.
