HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" TO SENATE AMENDMENT "A" ~~TO~~ S. P. 813,
L.D. 2355, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations
from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for
the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and
Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper
Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment in "Part A" under the caption "HUMAN
SERVICES" by striking out all of the last paragraph under
the heading "Aid to Families with Dependent Children" and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'At such time as an additional amount of up
to \$1,000,000 may be saved during 1976-77,
within the AFDC Program, from any source, such
funds shall be utilized to increase grant
payments.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the legislative intent concerning
the use of AFDC program savings to increase grant payments.
