Further amend said Amendment in PART A in the last line relating to "TOTAL GENERAL FUND - PART A" by adjusting the total to read correctly.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of PART D

Further amend said Amendment by relettering PARTSE to H to be PARTSD to G.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment removes from Senate Amendment "A" provisions providing for a pay increase for state employees and the Hay
