SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to Joint Order, S. P. 490

Amend said Order in the 6th paragraph by striking out in the last line the words "the Governor" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'joint agreement of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House'

Further amend said Order by striking out all of the 7th paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The committee shall hold its organizational meeting upon the call of the president and shall choose a chairman from among its membership at that time; and be it further'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the committee responsible to the Legislature instead of to the Governor.
