STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Operation of Vending Facilities by Blind Persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA § 3504, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 88, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The officers, board, or other authority in charge of such buildings shall not allow any other vending facility, mobile or stationary, to operate within reasonable proximity of said building.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA § 3508, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 88, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Suitable space is defined as 25 linear feet of countertop accessible to public with a minimum of 250 square feet for vending facility or as agreed to by the licensing agency.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide suitable space for blind vending facilities and to assist operators in becoming self-supporting in achieving independent livelihood.

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
