# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide a Mandatory Rehabilitation Program for Minors who Violate the Motor Vehicle Laws while under the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1312-B is enacted to read:

§ 1312-B. Mandatory rehabilitation program for minors

Any person under 18 years of age who operates or attempts to operate a motor vehicle within this State while under the influence of intoxicating liquor shall, upon conviction or adjudication of each offense, be required to complete a rehabilitation program provided under section 1312 prior to reinstatement of driving privilege.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to require a mandatory educational program for minors who violate the motor vehicle laws while under the influence of intoxicating liquor.
