STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Permit Savings Institutions to Offer Mortgages for Periods of up to 40 years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

9-B MRSA § 532, sub-§ 2, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 500, § 1, is amended to read:

Loans in an amount not exceeding 90% of the bank's appraisal of the market value; provided that the note or other obligation evidencing the loan shall require monthly payments of the interest and principal thereon at a rate of amortization sufficient to repay the entire loan within a period not exceeding 30 40 years, or shall require full payment of the loan within a period of 3 years.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to permit lending institutions to offer mortgages for periods of up to 40 years to enable more persons to purchase houses.
