**AN ACT Prohibiting Candidates from being Present when  
an Absentee Ballot is being Marked.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA, § 1579, sub-§ 30 is enacted to read:

30. Candidate present while an absentee ballot is marked. Any candidate whose name appears on an absentee ballot who is present while a registered voter is voting by such an absentee ballot.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will prohibit candidates from being present while a registered voter is voting by absentee ballot.
