AN ACT Relating to Removal of County Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 302, 1st sentence, is amended to read:

The county commissioners shall not remove a county building ~~in the shire town~~ or erect a new one instead of it ~~more than ½ a mile from the former location~~ **beyond the limits of the shire town**, without first giving notice of their intentions and of the place where they propose to locate it to the municipal officers of each town in the county.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to permit removal of county buildings to another location providing the location is within the limits of the shire town.
