COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 11, L.D. 20, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide that the First 5 Days of Deer Season Shall be for Maine Residents Only."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Provide that the Saturday Preceding the Open Deer Season shall be for Maine Residents Only.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §2353, next to last paragraph, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 403, §17, is amended to read:

It is provided that the commissioner is authorized to shorten the open season on deer in any area of the State, providing such determination is made and published prior to September 1st of any year and provided that in every county, the Saturday preceding the first day of the open season on deer shall be an open day for residents of this State only.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the Saturday preceding the ^{open deer}the/season shall be set aside for Maine residents in every county of the State.
