HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 25,
L.D. 34, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Property Tax Exemption for
Parsonages to \$50,000."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the first
2 lines and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Provide that the Property
Tax Exemption for Parsonages be \$20,000 of Just Value.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the word "value"
in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the underlined word 'just';
and by striking out in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the following:
"~~\$20,000~~ \$50,000" and inserting in its place the figure '\$20,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the exemption to
\$20,000.
