COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 25, L.D. 34, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Property Tax Exemption for Parsonages to \$50,000."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the Title the figure "\$50,000" and inserting in its place the figure '\$40,000'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the word "value" in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the underlined word 'just'; and by striking out in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50,000" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$40,000'

## Fiscal Note

This bill will cause no fiscal loss for 1978-79.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment increases the current real property exemption for parsonages from \$20,000 to \$40,000, but also required that the valuation figures used be the 100% real market value("just value"). Practically speaking, this means that if a town currently has a 50% assessment ratio, that is, all property is assessed at 50% of its all market value, then this change in the law would not increase decrease the exemption currently granted.
