COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 455, L.D. 560, Bill,
"AN ACT to Prohibit the Sale of Gasoline Below Cost to
Destroy Competition."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec.1. 10 MRSA §1453, sub-§13 is enacted to read;

- 13. Retail service station. "Retail service station"

 shall mean a facility operated by a retail dealer where

 motor fuels are sold to the public.
- Sec. 2. 10 MRSA \$1454-A is enacted to read: \$1454-A. Distributor as retail dealer

The invoice cost of motor gasoline for the purposes of chapter 205 for a retail service station operated by a distributor shall be the price the distributor charges to all other retail service stations in that market area.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendmentis to equalize the cost of motor gasoline to all retail service stations for the purposes of determining the required statutory mark up under the winfair sales act. This amendment will give non-distributor-operated retail stations an equal chance to compete against distributor-operated stations.
