COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 465, L.D. 570, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Registration for Governmental Vehicles."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end, before the period, of the first sentence of paragraph A of subsection 1 of that part designated "\$256." the following: 'except those used by the Attorney General or members of his staff'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'4. University of Maine vehicles. The Secretary of State is authorized to register vehicles owned by the University of Maine without the payment of registration fees prescribed by this Title. Such vehicles shall display registration plates of a design determined by the Secretary of State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt the Attorney General and his staff from having to be approved by the Commissioner of Public Safety when wishing to use unmarked vehicles and to provide for all University of Maine vehicles to be registered with the Secretary of State.
