SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 199, L.D. 577, Bill, "AN ACT Raising the Age of Persons who may Purchase Alcoholic Beverages or Sell as Licensees."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 7 and 8 and by renumbering sections 9 to 11 to be sections 7 to 9.

Statement of Fact

Deleting sections 7 and 8 from the bill would keep the law as presently written in regard to receiving payment for sale in retail stores and serving in class A restaurants.
