COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 474, L.D. 580, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Restrictive Licensing of Certain Financial Institutions."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "<u>§1514-A.</u>" in subsection 1, paragraph A in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "<u>corporation</u>," the underlined words and punctuation '<u>credit</u> union,'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated " $\underline{\$1514-A}$ " by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Prohibition as to financial institutions. No license as an agent, broker or consultant shall be issued to a financial institution, or any officer, agent, representative or employee thereof other than a director or trustee. Nothing in this section shall limit the activity of these organizations with respect to credit life and credit health insurance pursuant to chapter 37, group health insurance authorized pursuant to chapter 35 and group life insurance authorized pursuant to chapter 31.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated " $\underline{\$1514-A}$ " in subsection 3 by adding at the end the following underlined sentence:

'Nothing in this section shall limit the activity of the employee, officer, agent or associate of these organizations

with respect to credit life and credit health insurance pursuant to chapter 37, group health insurance authorized pursuant to chapter 35 and group life insurance authorized pursuant to chapter 31.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds "credit union" to the definition of financial institutions; substitutes the term financial institution instead of listing the various kinds of institutions included therein; and provides that an officer of a financial institution may not be an insurance agent or solicitor.
