**AN ACT to Require the Purchase of School Buses Through the Bureau  
of Purchases.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 220-A is enacted to read:

§ 220-A. Purchase and maintenance of school buses,  
materials and supplies

All school buses or service vehicles purchased by or for the account of any county or municipal educational unit or district, except school buses or service vehicles purchased by such unit or district from another county or municipal educational unit or district within this State, shall be purchased through the Bureau of Purchases, Department of Finance and Administration.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that all school buses or school vehicles for any county or municipality shall be purchased through the State Bureau of Purchases, Department of Finance and Administration.
