STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide Certain Travel Expenses for County Commissioners of all Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 106, 2nd ¶, 1st 2 sentences, as amended by PL 1975, c. 267, are further amended to read:

Except in Aroostook County, said salaries shall be in full for all services, expenses and travel to and from the county seat, including the management of the jails and workshops and the sale of their products. In Aroostook County, the The county commissioners shall be allowed compensated, in addition to their salaries, all necessary traveling expenses for meals, housing and travel in the same manner as state employees.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will allow county commissioners of all counties to be reimbursed for expenses in addition to their salaries in the same manner as state employees.
