HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1571, L.D. 1785, Bill,
"AN ACT to Improve Prosecution Services."

in
Amend the Bill in section 5/subsection 5 by striking out
all of the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (same in L.D.) and
inserting in their place the following:

- 'Prosecutorial District 6 \$40,000
- 'Prosecutorial District 7 \$40,000'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 7
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the
sum of \$898,000 for the payment of salaries of assistant
district attorneys. The breakdown shall be as follows:
