SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 508, L.D. 1793, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Water Quality Program."


Amend the bill in section 8 in the last line by inserting before the period ~~the~~ the underlined words 'where a commercially harvestable abundance of soft shell clams or quahogs occurs as determined by the Department of Marine Resources'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in the last line by inserting before the period ~~the~~ the words 'where a commercially harvestable abundance of soft shell clams or quahogs occurs as determined by the Department of Marine Resources'

Further amend the bill in section 12 in the last line by inserting before the period ~~the~~ the words 'where a commercially harvestable abundance of soft shell clams or quahogs occurs as determined by the Department of Marine Resources'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restrict the ^{prohibition of} discharge of treated or untreated sanitary waste waters to shellfishing areas where there is a commercially harvestable quantity of clams or quahogs.
