SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 518, L.D. 1810, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish an Assessment of Student Performance
in the Basic Skills."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Funding. Funds to cover this Act shall come
from any balances in account 1201.4, Federal Program
Administration on June 30, 1977, not to exceed \$48,000.
This balance shall not lapse but shall be carried forward
until June 30, 1978.'
