SENATE AMENDMENT"A" to H.P. 1661, L.D. 1857, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent the Display of Adult Magazines to Minors."

Amend the bill in that part designated "<u>§2906.</u>" subsection 1, by striking out all of paragraph B.

Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>§2906.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Nudity defined. For purposes of this section, "nudity" means any visual representation by photographic or other means, showing the human male or female genitals, public area or buttocks with less than a full opaque covering, or the showing of the adult female breasts with less than a full opaque covering on any portion thereof below the top of the nipple, or the depiction of covered male genitals in a discernably turgid state.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent the display of nudity to minors on the covers of books, magazines or newspapers.
