## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1896, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 106 the following:

'Sec. 106-A. 29 MRSA §1373, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 222, §7, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

This section shall not apply to mopeds, as defined in section 1, subsection 5-A.

Sec. 106-B. Repeal. Section 106-A shall be repealed 90 days after adjournment of the first regular session of the 108th Legislature.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment ensures that the motorcycle helmet law will not apply to mopeds. While the helmet requirement law will no longer be effective 90 days after the Legislature adjourns, it will still be effective until that time. This law was not intened to and should not affect mopeds for the remaining portion of its life.
