Amend the Amendment on page 27 by striking out everything after the 5th paragraph and everything on page 28 except for the last 2 paragraphs and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 768 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 768. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:
