HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to S. P. 748, L.D. 2199, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 371. 17 MRSA §314, first ¶, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 307, §2, is amended to read:

Said 2 years' limitation shall not apply to any chartered posts of terans organizations, nationally established, even though such posts have not been in existence for 2 years prior to their application for a license nor shall the 2 years' limitation apply to any volunteer fire department or rescue unit; and provided that a license may be issued to an agricultural fair association when sponsored, operated and conducted for the benefit of such agricultural fair association.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt municipal fire departments and rescue units from ^{the} 2-year requirement before applying for beano licenses.
