SENATE AMENDMENT " N " to S. P. 748, L.D. 2199, Bill,

"AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 371. 28 MRSA \$101, 3rd ¶ from the end, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 630, §2, is amended to read:

Except as otherwise provided therein, the petition process and elections
the voting at meetings/held in towns and plantations shall be
held and conducted in accordance with Title 30, sections 2061, 2062 and
2065, even though the town or plantation has not accepted the
provisions of section 2061, and the voting at meetings elections
held in cities shall be held and conducted in accordance with
Title 21.
