SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 772, L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION, :  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Limit the Amount  
of Government Spending and Taxes which may be Made without Voter  
Approval.

Amend the resolution in the 4th paragraph by striking out  
all of the 2nd sentence which reads: "Tax rates shall be adjusted  
to minimize such excesses."

Further amend the resolution in paragraph C of subsection 6  
of that part designated "Constitution, Art. 1, §22, sub-§§ 1 to 7  
are enacted to read:" by striking out at the end of subparagraph (4)  
the last word "and"

Further amend the resolution in paragraph C of subsection 6  
of that part designated "Constitution, Art. 1, §22, sub-§§ 1 to 7  
are enacted to read:" by striking out the period at the end of sub-  
paragraph (5) and inserting in its place the following: 'and'

Further amend the resolution in paragraph C of subsection 6  
of that part designated "Constitution, Art. 1, §22, sub-§§ 1 to 7  
are enacted to read:" by inserting after subparagraph (5) the  
following:

'(6) For the State Government, upward to the extent it provides  
property tax relief.'
