Further amend the Amendment on Page 3 by striking out in
the 4th line from the end the underlined words "Expenditures
of dedicated" and inserting in their place the underlined words
'Expenditures from existing dedicated'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the
last 2 paragraphs before the statement of fact and inserting
in their place the following:

Resolution

'Further amend the / by striking out all of the last 3
paragraphs before the constitutional referendum procedure.'


