COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2344, L.D. 2211,  
RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Require  
the Governing Body of State and Local Units of Government to  
Establish Reasonable Expenditure Limits for their Respective Units;  
to Provide Property Tax Relief by Requiring Property Tax Exemption  
on the First \$10,000 on an Owner's Principal Place of Residence;  
to Provide Property Tax Relief to Renters; and to Finance  
Property Tax Relief by Providing that a One Percent Sales and  
Use Tax shall be Collected by the State and Distributed to Local  
Governments.
