HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to
H.P. 2345, L.D. 2212, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to
the Constitution to Limit the Amount of Revenues which may
be Raised by Taxes in any Fiscal Year.

Amend the Amendment in the 13th line after the title
by inserting after the underlined figures and punctuation
"1979," the following: 'nor expenditures of the proceeds
of state levied taxes on owners of products or resources
used to promote or protect such products and resources.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it clear that proceeds of the
so-called self-imposed taxes are excluded.
