HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
2346, L.D. 2213, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the
Constitution to Limit the Maximum Property Tax which can be
Levied.

Amend the Amendment on page 5 in that part designated
"§1523." in subsection 3 by striking out all of the first
sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'The State shall not require local units of government to fund
any programs not in effect on the effective date of this chapter,
nor require them to fund expansion of present programs, unless
the State contributes to local units at least 50% of the cost
of that program or expansion.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the State to establish new local
programs or expand present local programs if it assumes 50% of
the cost of these mandates.
