HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
H.P. 2346, L.D. 2213, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the  
Constitution to Limit the Maximum Property Tax which can be  
Levied.

Amend the Amendment on page 4 in that part designated  
"§1522." in subsection 3 by striking out all of paragraph G  
and by relettering paragraphs H to K to be paragraphs G to J.

Further amend the Amendment on page 6 by striking out all  
of that part designated "§1524." and inserting in its place the  
following:

'§1524. Use of excess revenues

All revenues accruing to the State in excess of the  
limitation in section 1522 and not removed from the limitation  
section 1522,  
by/subsections 2, 3, 4 or 5, shall be used to fund reductions  
in taxes on property used as principal places of residence.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the language relating to the  
appropriation of excess revenues.
