
SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P.
2347, L.D. 2214, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Property Tax
Relief."

Amend the Amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the
first underlined sentence and inserting in its place the
following:

'If the surplus is not sufficient to provide the full benefits
under section 6148, the State Budget Officer shall certify
the amount of the surplus, and the benefits under section 6148 shall
be prorated proportionally so that the actual amount certified
shall be distributed under that section.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that if the ^{State} ~~the~~ Budget Officer
certifies that a sufficient surplus does not exist to
fully fund the benefits of section 6148 he shall certify
the actual amount of the surplus, and the amount of the
benefit shall be prorated so that the full amount of the existing
surplus will be distributed.
