HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2347, L.D. 2214, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Property Tax Relief."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of sub-
section 2 of that part designated "§6147." and inserting in
its place the following:

'2. Homestead. "Homestead" means all or part of a building,
including a mobile home, used by the occupant as his principal
place of abode, but does not include housing, other than public
housing, which is not subject to property taxation.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include tenants of
public housing as recipients of the homestead rebate. It is
estimated that the additional expense of this amendment can
be absorbed within the existing appropriation.
