SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to H.P. 2347, L. D. 2214, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Property Tax Relief."


Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection
5 of that part designated "\$6149." and inserting in its place
the following:

'5. Application to elderly householders. The benefit
awarded under this chapter shall be in addition to any benefit
awarded under chapter 901 for property taxes assessed as of
April 1, 1978 or the rent equivalent thereof, provided that
the combined amount of benefits provided by both chapters
shall not exceed the benefit limitation provided by section
6112.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment accomplishes the following:

If a claimant under the Elderly Householders Tax and
Rent Refund Act is not receiving a full rebate, this amendment
will allow him to receive up to \$64 (householders) or \$32 (renters).
For instance, if his taxes are \$500, an elderly rebate of the \$400
maximum plus an additional rebate of \$64 under this amendment
would be allowed.
