HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Joint Order to study the problem of alcoholism and alcohol abuse and methods of treatment and rehabilitation, H.P. 1547

Amend the Order by striking out all of the 5th paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Ordered, the Senate concurring, subject to the Legislative Council's review and determination hereinafter provided, that a select committee be appointed consisting of 3 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional Services, 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs and 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Education^{to} be appointed by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives jointly. The committee shall elect a chairman who shall serve at the pleasure of the committee; and be it further

Ordered, that the committee study the problem of alcoholism and alcohol abuse and methods of treatment and rehabilitation in education, including the client-oriented system; and be it further'
