SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1857, Joint Resolution  
requesting the Attorney General to examine the price increases  
in petroleum products.

Amend the Resolution by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd,  
4th and 5th paragraphs and inserting in their place the  
following:

'Whereas, it appears that citizens of Maine have been,  
during the past year,' overcharged by oil companies, for  
petroleum products which are a necessity of life; and

Whereas, the citizens of Maine feel a sense of frustration  
due to their apparent inability to gain recourse against this  
profiteering; and

Whereas, existing law may provide that recourse; and

Whereas, the Attorney General's office has not conducted  
any investigation into these possible overcharges and any  
possible recourse under existing law; and

Whereas, the Legislature deems such an investigation to  
be of a high priority; now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That we, the members of the 109th Legislature  
on behalf of the people of the State, urge and request the  
Attorney General of the State to examine these recent price  
increases made by oil companies and determine whether any  
violations of existing law have occurred; and be it further'
