IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Remove Moose River from the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA \S 1201, 8th \P which relates to Somerset County, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1965, c. 226, \S 34, is amended to read:

Municipalities: Moose River, Moscow, Brighton Plantation, Caratunk Plantation, Dennistown Plantation, Highland Plantation, Pleasant Ridge Plantation, The Forks Plantation, West Forks Plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove Moose River from the Maine Forestry District.
