AN ACT to Increase the Compensation for Substitute Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 1901, 3rd ¶ from end, as repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 462, is amended to read:

Substitute teachers with 4 years of study beyond the high school and with a bachelor's degree and in possession of a standard teachers' certificate and substitute teachers who have retired after a minimum of 15 years teaching shall be compensated at the rate of not less than ~~\$20~~ **\$30** for each day of service.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to increase the amount of compensation for substitute teachers to a more appropriate level in keeping with the times and the professional services being rendered.
