HOUSE AMENDMENT<sup>"A"</sup> to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 5, L.D.  
11, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Smoking at Public Meetings."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Conditions where smoking in public proceedings are permitted. Smoking at a public proceeding shall be allowed provided all members present are smokers and have given their consent for others to smoke.'

5. Violation. Violation of this section, after warning, shall be a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$50 may be adjudged.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a subsection on conditions where smoking in public proceedings are allowed.
