SENATE AMENDMENT $^{"}$ A COMMITTEE AMENDMENT $^{"}$ A $^{"}$ to H.P. 5, L.D. 11, Bill, $^{"}$ AN ACT to Prohibit Smoking at Public Meetings."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

- '4. Conditions where smoking in public proceedings are permitted. Smoking at a public proceeding shall be allowed provided all members present have given their consent for others to smoke.
- 5. Violation. Violation of this section, after warning, shall be a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$50 may be adjudged.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow local control at public meetings and still give the nonsmoker the right to clean air.
